

100 Women \$100 campaign

Is it just for women donors?

- No, men can donate in honor of a woman in their life. We want to focus on women powering the campaign, but men are more than welcome to make a contribution to honor someone they love.

Does the donation have to be \$100?

- No, but \$100 is suggested. Donors giving less than \$100 will be recognized as donors to the campaign/annual fund, but will not be assigned a number or receive the donor gift of a custom-made numbered necklace.

How are numbers assigned to donors?

- Donors will receive the next available number at the time of their donation. Unfortunately we cannot assign numbers based on requests.

How will my contribution be recognized?

- You will receive a "Girls Rock! Seattle" guitar pick necklace with your donor number on it. In addition, your name will appear on our website as a contributor to the campaign. We will also list you in our annual report as a donor to the campaign and on a "donor board" at upcoming events listing our donors & their donor numbers.

What if I want to remain anonymous?

- You will still receive your thank-you gift (unless you request not to) but will be listed as "Anonymous" on our public donor acknowledgment listings. It is important to us to show anonymous donors as well as those who choose to make their names public because it reinforces the fantastic community support we receive, including those who choose to remain private with their donation. Since each donor will be assigned a number (1-100) your anonymous donation will have a number associated with it and will show up as that number in our donor recognition (for instance, Anonymous #7).

Can I make a donation with a group of friends?

- Absolutely! Gather as many friends as you would like and make a group donation of \$100. Your group will be assigned one donor number and will receive one necklace.

Can I make a pledge rather than a donation right now?

- Yes, you can make a pledge. When your pledge is fulfilled you will be assigned the next available donor number and will receive your numbered necklace at that time.

When will I get my gift?

- We expect that gifts will take about 6-8 weeks to arrive.

Can I refuse the gift in order for my whole donation to be tax deductible?

- Yes, you can. You will still be assigned the donor number associated with your gift, but you will not receive a gift thus making your entire donation tax deductible.

Why a \$10,000 campaign? What is the money being used for?

- Girls Rock! Seattle is doubling its capacity for campers in only its second year of existence! We made it through the first camp with mostly loaned instruments and equipment from our Board members, volunteers, music instructors and community members. In order to equip 80 girls we need to purchase some additional items before summer camp! We have annual equipment expenses built into our budget, but we were not expecting the need to double capacity so soon in the life of the organization. \$10,000 will also help us launch our 2010 year with money for the increased camp space to house twice as many band rooms, instruction rooms and workshop spaces, as well as providing funding for additional supplies for camp. We are also hoping to be able to alleviate some of the pressures of the uncertain economy by beginning a small reserves

account to carry us through each year with certainty that we will see another year to serve our girls!
